

Springfield Ceramics and Crafts Club Youth Art Outreach Grant

The Springfield Ceramics and Crafts Club is offering two grants (\$500 each) to promote fine arts knowledge and practice for school-age children in Springfield, Illinois. This project is open to art teachers/art programs in Springfield schools.

This project may be used for (but is not limited to) the following:

- Promoting the understanding of an artist's work or an art genre.
- Improving the school building environment with an art project executed by the students.
- Learning about the Springfield community and sharing the information through art projects which culminate in an art show.
- Teaching the students new art techniques and ways to incorporate them into mixed media art projects.
- Reclaiming and repurposing non-traditional items into art creations.

The S.C.C.C. would like a summary report of the project at its conclusion. The written report should be one page or less and should include a photographic record of the project's implementation and the final results (or examples of the final products). We would like to exhibit the final report and photos at our Spring Luncheon which takes place in April.
